 - c. Visit colleges either in person or through virtual tours.
- 4. Create a CSU Mentor and California Colleges account: www.csumentor.edu and www.californiacolleges.edu
 - a. Use your School ID for your username
 - b. Use your birth date for PW
- 5. Complete the High School Planner through California colleges for UC/CSU Planner using current transcript. You can also do the Independent Planner if you would like.
- 6. Sign up take the PSAT in October
- 7. Sign up to take the SAT and the ACT with Writing during the Spring. (Sign up by December)
 - a. Create accounts at www.actstudent.org
 - b. See counseling for fee waiver information if needed
 - c. Take again during summer (Sigh up by March)
- 8. Start thinking about paying for college.
 - a. Visit the OHHS Career Center
 - b. Apply for at least 1 scholarship per month
 - i. Complete Auto Biography
 - ii. Start a student portfolio with achievements and volunteer information.
 - c. Create a Fast Web Account (<u>www.fastweb.com</u>)
