- Request official transcripts. The registrar need ONE week notice, minimum.
- Ask teachers, community members and club advisors for letters of recommendation. Be courteous and ask at least ONE week in advance.
- Prepare your personal autobiography (how to tips and samples in Career Center).
- Prepare your activities, honors, service list (how to tips and samples in Career Center).
- Check other websites on your own, see the Bulldog Career Center Website list for recommendations.
